

# Origami Snood

Skill Level : ♥♥♥♥♥♥



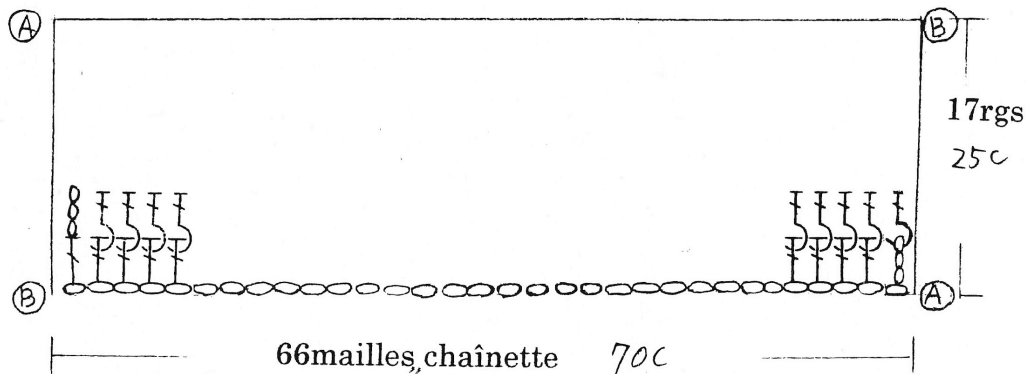
**Suggested Wool** : Atelier Yarn Mohair, DK weight, 131 Yards - 120m

**Alternative yarns** : 2 skeins of Kid Silk from Drops or Kid Silk from Debbie Bliss (or equivalent) - Held the Yarn in double

**Hook** : 6mm / J - 10 or 7 mm (according to the yarn)

**Yarn Needle**

**Finished Measurements** : Approx 10"/25 cm Wide x 27 ½" /70 cm Long



Ch 66.

**Row 1** : Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in every chain until the end - 66 dc.

**Row 2** : ch 3, FPdc in every st(s) until the end - 66 dc.

Repeat the Row 2, 15 more times. You now have 17 rows. Fasten off.

Sew as a Mobius : A with A and B with B.

Weave in all ends.

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**Notes : For a long cowl, ch 140 and use 4 skeins of Kid silk.**

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American term :

**Abbreviations:** ch = chain; dc = double crochet; **FDdc** = Front post double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es)

**Special Abbreviations FPdc (Front Post double crochet):** Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around post of indicated st; yo and draw up lp, [yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] twice.
